Now it's time to design your own costume! You can design a costume for a character you are studying, a character from *Rodelinda* or someone from your own writings!

Things to consider while designing: colours, character personality, texture of material, style, etc.

It helps to look at pictures in books and magazines to help!

### **Ambitions, Motives and Actions**

After seeing the production divide your class into 6 groups. Give each group a large sheet of paper and some markers. Assign a character from the Opera to each group. They should write the name of their character at the top of the page.

RODELINDA: Queen of Lombardy

GRIMOALDO: Duke of Benevento, usurper of Bertarido's throne

GARIBALDO: Duke of Turin, Grimoaldo's counselor

EDUIGE: Bertarido's sister, betrothed to Grimoaldo

BERTARIDO: Rodelinda's husband, usurped King of Lombardy

UNULFO: Bertarido's friend, counsellor to Grimoaldo

Have the groups discuss and brainstorm their character's ambitions, their motives and the actions they took to achieve their goals. Each group should then present their character to the class. After each group has presented discuss as a class the positive and negative actions used to further the characters' ambitions. Discuss goal setting and how to positively achieve those goals.

Discuss the the idea of positive affirmations when working towards a goal. How does the power of positive thinking help us achieve the goals we set for ourselves? How can we turn small failures into positive affirmations?
